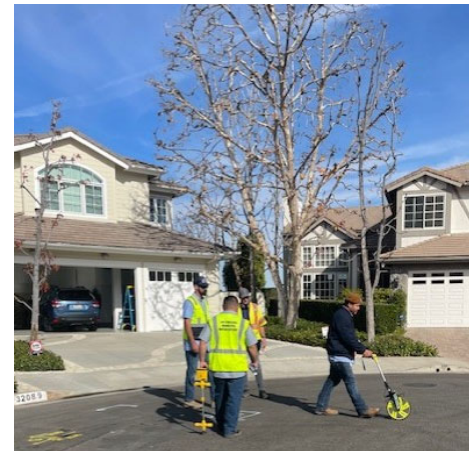


# Proactive Leak Detection Program Launch

- **Launched March 2026**

- Contractor Hydrevo and Construction team survey to detect leaks in advance of main breaks
- 3 weeks at a time, 2x/year
- First round concluded in early April, with initial results showing promise
  - >50 leaks found
  - Education/training for staff with leak detection equipment
  - Pipeline condition assessment – to inform survey locations

**Goal = Reduce water loss; minimize main breaks**



## AB 1572

### What is Non-Functional Turf (NFT)?

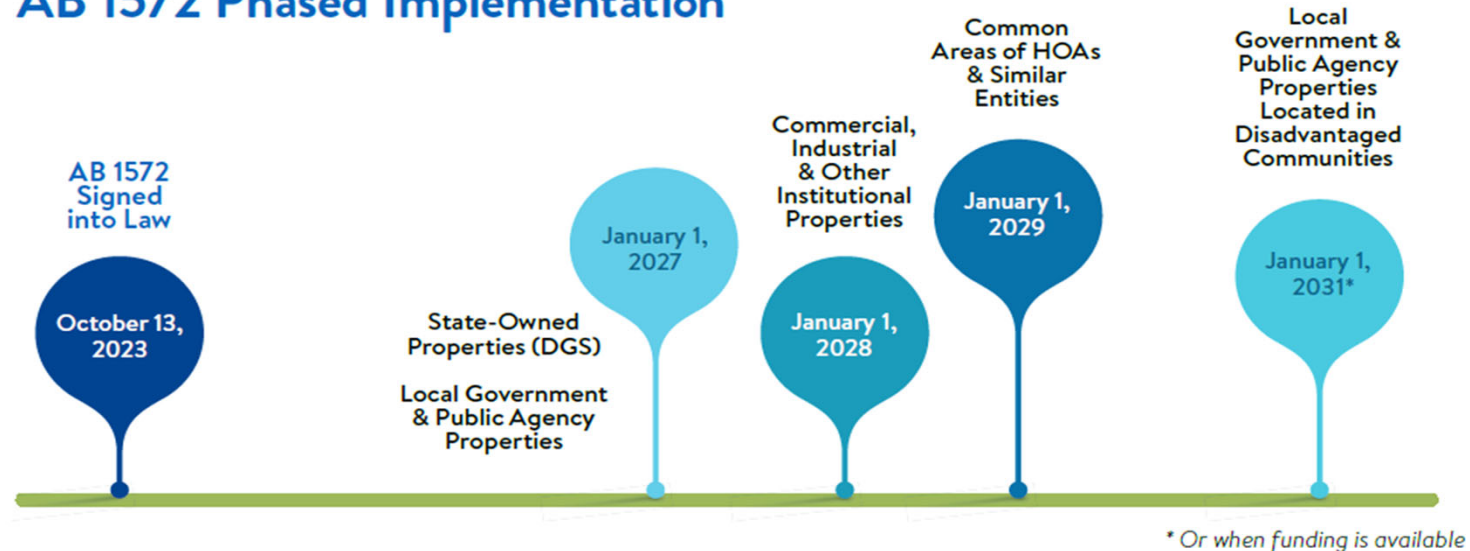
- Irrigated lawn that is purely ornamental and not regularly used for recreation or public gatherings
- **Exemptions:** tree irrigation, public parks, cemeteries, and health/safety needs



# AB 1572 Compliance

## AB 1572 Phased Implementation

- Prohibits potable water use for irrigating nonfunctional turf (NFT) on commercial, industrial, institutional (CII) properties, and HOAs.

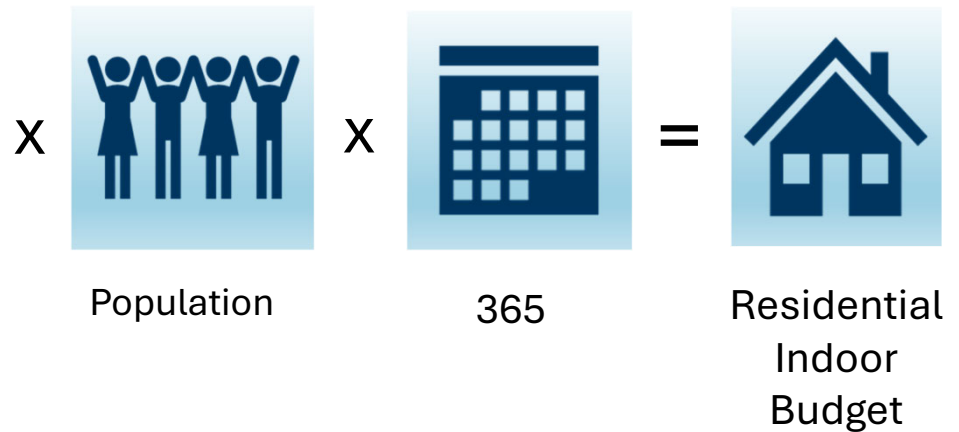


- Required by January 1, 2027: Water suppliers must adopt an ordinance for AB 1572 compliance and communicate with customers.
- Adoption of this ordinance ensures regulatory compliance and supports water conservation efforts.
- Enforcement may include supplier-levied civil penalties for noncompliance.

# SB 1157 - Residential Indoor Budget

Defined in Water Code Section 10609.4

Year	1157 Standards - DWR/SWRCB Recommendation (GPCD)
2020-2024	55
2025-2029	47
2030 +	42



# SB 1157 Benefits and Impacts Study

1. **Technical assistance and data** to help Suppliers and related water utilities:
  - ❖ Understand where they are at and where they might be in 2030 related to indoor residential water use standard, only.
  - ❖ Focus efforts and resources.
  - ❖ Understand how telework situation has affected things.
2. **Recommend**, jointly with the State Water Board, if **a later implementation date** would mitigate some affordability impacts.
3. **Recommend** to State Water Board **variances** to help mitigate impacts.

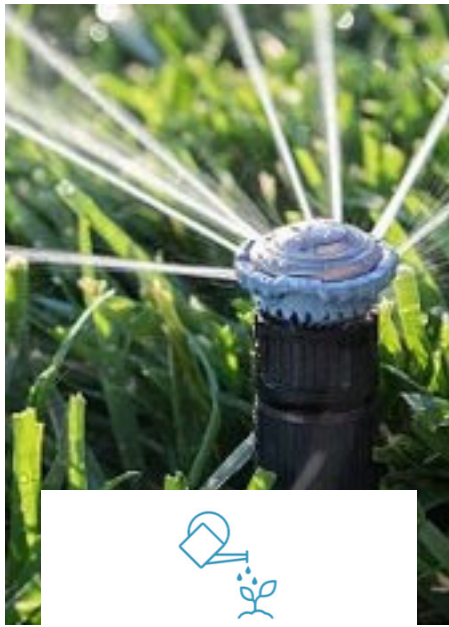

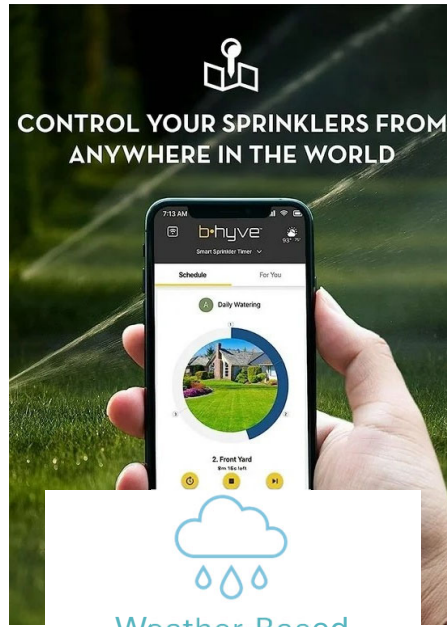

Surveys Completed = **604**

Irrigation Retrofit Installs = **390**

Controllers Installed = **193**

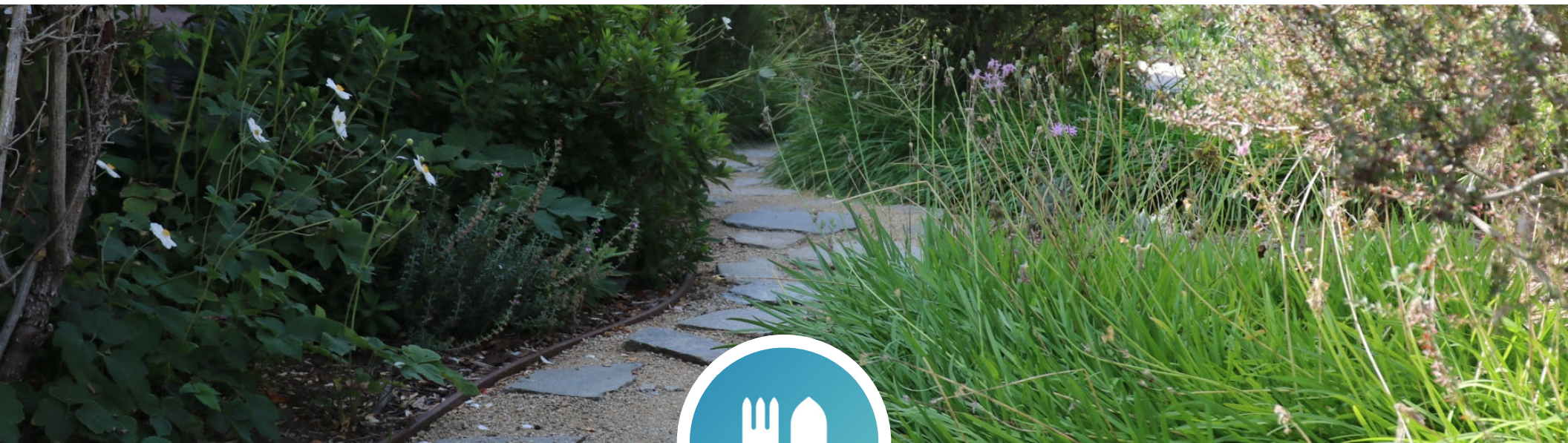
Drip Irrigation Installed = **22,655**

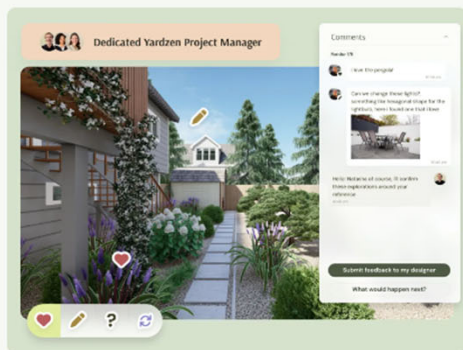
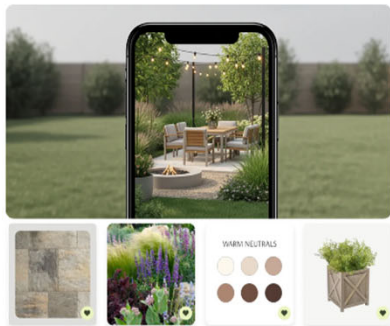
